



Company Liaison

Purpose: The Company Liaison is the key relationship that coordinates with the Program Director of MPC to deliver the impact to and through your organization. Through this ongoing relationship, the program is adapted to the people and processes of the partnering organization, and the local community.

Time Commitment: 3-4 hours monthly

Role Candidate: This individual knows the employees, company culture and mission, and is skilled at non-profit and community collaboration.

Scheduling On-site activities: Integrates employee education, recruitment, and on-site activities into the existing company structure to minimize organizational challenges, while optimizing collaborative impact.

Employee Mentor Candidates: Recruit 3-5 employee mentor candidates

Community Collaboration: Facilitates introductions between program director and established community partners, for a strong coalition of student/family services.

Work-Based Mentee Opportunities: The long-term vision of this work-integrated program is to facilitate a vocational conduit for students to experience work at quality organizations. Your organization can explore providing internships and employment in season two and beyond.

Program Evaluation: The Liaison will also collaborate with our program director to define success, evaluate outcomes, and relate company experience and improvement opportunities.

Advisory Board Engagement: The liaison would be an excellent candidate for our advisory board, a volunteer mentor, or executive team member.
